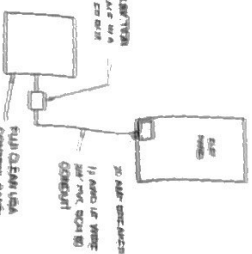
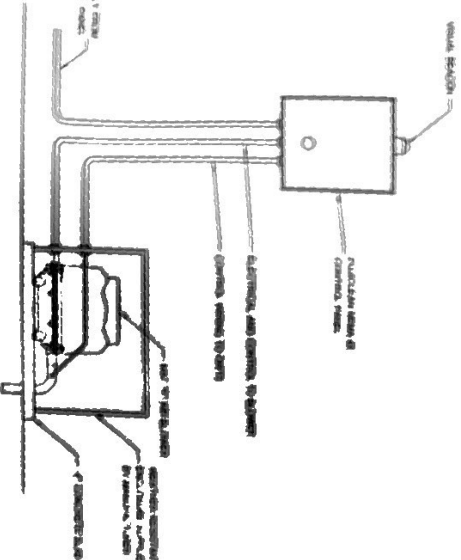


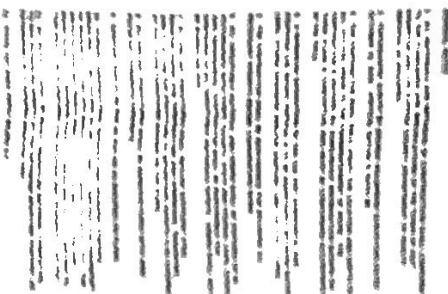

ELECTRIC RISER DIAGRAM



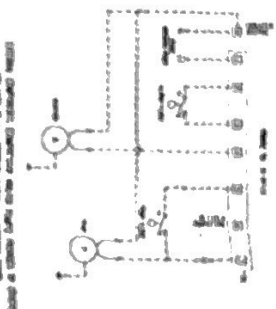
FUJICLEAN CONTROL PANEL AND BLOWER DETAIL



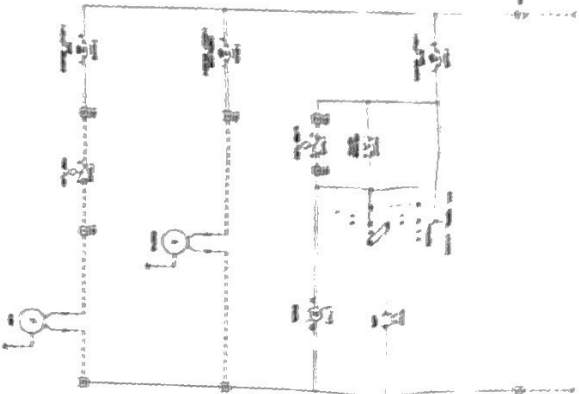
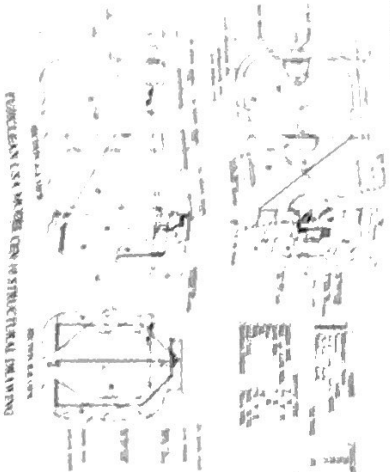

CONTROL PANEL WIRING DIAGRAM P 1

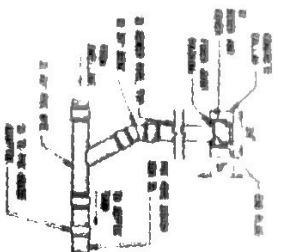

ALARM/CONTROL PANEL WIRING DIAGRAM P. 2

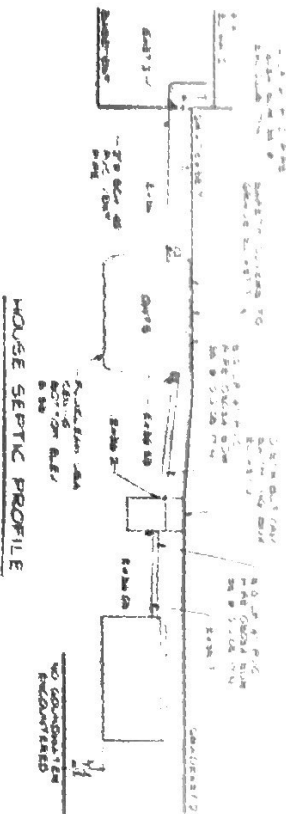
